Keep Yourself Dry From Both Weather and Perspiration

Moisture can reduce the insulating properties of everything. It is important to protect yourself from getting wet to keep yourself from getting hypothermia or frostbite. Your outerwear should keep you warm by blocking the wind and, most impor-
